York County Development Facilitator Position

As York County has grown from an agricultural community to a more residential and business community and as the region has grown, new developers, business owners and residents, not previously familiar with the ordinances and regulations, are doing business in York County. With this growth the need for a more complex ordinance to address emerging development issues arose. It became apparent that the complexities of the regulations created a need to have someone who can be pro-active and reach out to the business community to explain, interpret and guide the design professionals, developers and residents through the regulations, review and permitting process.

The Development Facilitator position is designed to educate and assist developers,

residents, and business owners concerning the ordinances, regulations and review

processes from their first contact with York County to their grand opening. The goal is to

make the process easier to understand and navigate through in a timelier manner.

York County staff, elected officials and the Chamber of Commerce have pledged

complete support and commitment to bettering the business climate in York County. As

part of this commitment, the Development Facilitator position is focused on providing

individual assistance to developers, business owners and residents as a to achieve the

goals of bettering the business climate in the County. The goals of the Development

Facilitator are as follows:

Develop a rapport with the business community by attending York County

Chamber of Commerce and other business community sponsored events and

meetings.

Work closely with the Office of Economic Development, in assisting new

businesses relocating to York County.

Meet with developers, business owners and residents during the conceptual state

of their projects to educate them on the appropriate land use, any special

requirements, regulations or overlay districts.

Promote the use of the Development Guide, authored in conjunction with the

Office of Economic Development and the Division of Development and

Compliance and is an important tool providing information about the review

process in a concise, user friendly format.

• Encourage the use, when appropriate, of the pre-application processes to

provide a "fast-track" 21 day review for commercial development projects, rather

than the normal 60 day review time frame.

Maintain contact with the project application throughout the entire process from

conceptual stage to grand opening.

Provide pre-certificate of occupancy site compliance inspections for the project as

requested by the developer or contractor to ensure the project is on the right

track, helping to ensure the official certificate of occupancy inspection for site

design and compliance is able to be approved smoothly and quickly.

Accomplishments achieved to date are:

Assisted in the development of and participated in the York County's Developer's

Training program (February 2010) to provide an educational opportunity for local

area design professionals. The training reviewed the York County- specific

development regulations and processes, provided updated information on

ordinances and review top mistakes made in commercial development.

Attendees received continuing education credits and are listed on the York

County's websites as recommended companies doing business in York County.

Worked closely with the Office of Economic Development, the Division of

Development and Compliance and the Division of Computer Support Services to

develop and maintain a "construction" layer for the existing on-line property

map, accessed by the public. This new layer allows the public to see what

commercial or large residential projects have been approved and the future construction site of the project.

The cost of implementing the Development Facilitator position is \$48,750 annually, but the results since implementation have equaled 900 developers, business owners and residents have been assisted by the Development Facilitator, with contacts increasing monthly as more members of the community become aware of and utilize the services provided. In 2009 projects that were assisted resulted in 22 new jobs and \$183,250.00 in new investment in York County.
