

Carbon Monoxide Awareness & Prevention Program for Seniors

“Detecting the Invisible Killer”

Carbon monoxide (CO) is a toxic gas, but being colorless, odorless, tasteless and non-irritating, it is very difficult for people to detect. Extended over-exposure to CO may lead to death.

The “Detecting the Invisible Killer” program will provide seniors with training on the symptoms and dangers of CO poisoning; and help them identify sources and clues to a possible carbon monoxide problem in their homes. In addition, **York County seniors will receive free CO detectors.**

How do I receive my **FREE** Carbon Monoxide Detector?

- Be a Senior and a York County resident.
- Attend one of the Carbon Monoxide Safety sessions presented by York County Fire and Life Safety.
- Homebound York County seniors who can not attend the sessions should call **York County Housing Office at 890-3885** for CO information and a free detector.
