



The VACSB represents the CSB/BHAs in state and federal public policy matters, including state and federal funding. In Virginia, the VACSB works to build consensus on policy, administrative and operational issues of CSB/BHAs and to represent those issues to the state agencies who most relate to the CSB/BHAs, to the Governor of Virginia, and to the Virginia General Assembly. VACSB advocates with partnerships, provides training and development for CSB/BHA staff and board members, private providers and partnership organizations. Additionally, the VACSB engages in public education activities that help the public understand, not only **the needs** of children and adults with mental illness, mental retardation, and substance use disorders, but the abilities of, and contributions made to their communities by, these individuals.

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
