Dear Local Government/Schools Administrator:

The 2015 Virginia Acts of the Assembly, Chapter 665, Item 82.H. (see <a href="http://communique.agencies.virginia.gov/Various/Item82Hbudgetact.pdf">http://communique.agencies.virginia.gov/Various/Item82Hbudgetact.pdf</a>) directs the Department of Human Resource Management (DHRM) to conduct an actuarial review of the impact of including local governments, school divisions and other political subdivisions in the state employee health benefits plan or in one statewide plan for employees of political subdivisions. The Act requires participation by all local government and school entities. Other political subdivisions may also participate.

DHRM has engaged Aon Consulting to conduct this analysis. Please refer to the instructions at the link below and complete the requests for general information as well as current plan design, census and claims data. We recommend using the Mozilla Firefox browser to open the link.
