Essential duties and responsibilities include: providing support to Family Services Specialists and families; transporting children to and from family visits between foster families and birth parent(s); transporting to and from appointments (i.e.; counseling, doctors; supervised biological family visits; and supervised trial home visits to oversee safety of the child (ren)). Also Ensures appropriateness of visits and interactions; accurate and timely entering of data into the state database for performance measures and statistical data; providing information to the birth families to help them understand the foster care process; testifying in court proceedings relative to any interactions with children and families; working closely with Child Protective Services Unit to assist with multiple job functions including the removal of children from abuse/neglect situations and/or finding appropriate placements as needed; and providing crisis intervention, training, and locating resources for children and families, and other duties as assigned.
