The Montgomery County General Services Department is seeking a **Consolidated Site Supervisor** to oversee the County's ten consolidated waste sites plus one unmanned site. The position will perform routine, unskilled manual work in support of various solid waste collection functions, including clean-ups, transporting collection containers, light repairs, and loading and unloading of materials, tools, and equipment. Recyclable materials, such as white goods, electronics, barrels of oil, single stream, paper, and cardboard are also collected. Supervisory duties include recruitment, evaluation of performance, disciplinary process, scheduling, and training of staff.

The successful candidate will possess a High School Diploma/GED, with some supervisory experience and knowledge of machinery and tools. The position requires excellent customer service skills and the ability to work effectively in both an independent and team environment. Valid Virginia driver's license and driver history that meets insurability guidelines required.
