Primary functions include: review land use applications; ensure compliance with ordinances, statutes, and regulations; provide professional planning services; gather and analyze data; provide support to department director and various boards and committees; prepare plans for special projects related to parks, trails, transportation, and economic development; prepare grant applications and provide grant administration for various projects; and perform related tasks as required.

Skills & Qualifications: Candidate must have thorough knowledge of the principles and practices of planning and zoning; general knowledge of current literature and recent developments in the field of planning and zoning; general knowledge and experience with ArcGIS, Adobe InDesign, Microsoft Office and other software programs needed to clearly convey information; ability to interpret various rules and regulations; ability to prepare and present technical information clearly; and ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with associates and the general public.
