The Montgomery County General Services Department is seeking a **Stormwater Program Manager**. This position performs, oversees, and leads the County's Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) permit program. This position performs the duties required including, but not limited to administrative, plan review, and field reconnaissance to meet all MS4 obligations. This includes the review, inspection, and compliance enforcement for land disturbing activities covered by the County's land disturbance permit and General Permit for Construction Activities under the NPDES program of the federal Clean Water Act. This position also provides technical support and guidance to local developers, engineers, contractors, consultants, and citizens concerning regulated land-disturbing activities. Candidate must have thorough knowledge of the Virginia MS4 Permit requirements and Virginia Stormwater Management Program. Knowledge of the principles and practices of civil engineering as related to the preparation of plans and specifications for a wide variety of public works and engineering projects is essential, as well as, knowledge of land and engineering survey systems methods and techniques. It is critical that the position works well with the public, staff, elected officials, and regulators.

A bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university in environmental sciences, environmental engineering, civil engineering, natural sciences, or a relevant field is required; six years of related experience is preferred. The successful candidate will demonstrate the ability to communicate clearly orally and in writing and have the ability to lead and present information in public meetings. Extensive knowledge of federal, state, and local laws, regulations, and standards associated with stormwater management is essential. The candidate must also have the ability to explain code interpretations and departmental policies to staff and customers with firmness and tact.
